## KARL ROVE TO DISCUSS 2010 MID-TERM ELECTIONS AT THE NATIONAL CONSTITUTION CENTER

Philadelphia, PA (September 8, 2010) – Political strategist **Karl Rove**, former senior adviser and deputy chief of staff to former President George W. Bush, will join the National Constitution Center on Monday, September 27 at 6:30 p.m. to discuss the approaching 2010 mid-term elections. With the Congress, numerous Governor's offices, and state houses up for grabs, Rove will address the political landscape, providing expert insight into polling, candidates, and the immediate and long-term implications of the November vote from the Republican Party perspective. Admission is \$9 for members, \$15 for non-members, \$7 for students and teachers, and free for 1787 Society members. Reservations are required and can be made by calling 215.409.6700.

**Karl Rove** is a political strategist and best-selling author of *Courage and Consequence*. He was deputy chief of staff and senior advisor to President George W. Bush and is credited by many with successfully steering the 2000 and 2004 presidential election campaigns. Prior to working in the administration, Rove was president of Karl Rove + Company, a public affairs firm. He is now a columnist for the *Wall Street Journal* and *Newsweek*, as well as a contributor to Fox News.

The Mid-term Election Overview with Karl Rove is the first of a two-part series at the National Constitution Center. An upcoming companion program on the midterm elections will feature a prominent Democratic political analyst.
