## **Casey, Santorum Square Off on 6abc**

*Final Leg in Race for U.S. Senate*  
**LIVE Debate From National Constitution Center, October 16<sup>th</sup> at 7pm**

Philadelphia (PA) – It's one of the most highly contested political races in the country, and 6abc, the National Constitution Center, and the League of Women Voters are proud to sponsor the third and final Senatorial debate between Republican incumbent Rick Santorum, and Democratic challenger Bob Casey. The rival candidates will square off Monday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, LIVE from the National Constitution Center. This one-hour special will be broadcast at 7pm, on 6abc, as well as on 6abc radio @ 87.7 FM. The debate will also stream, live, on [www.6abc.com](http://www.6abc.com).

Moderators Jim Gardner, of *Action News*, and George Stephanopoulos, host of ABC's *This Week*, will pose questions for the two candidates. The candidates will also field questions from a press panel consisting of representatives from *The Philadelphia Inquirer*, *The Philadelphia Tribune*, and *WFMZ-TV* in Allentown. The debate will include closing statements, and an opportunity for candidates to question each other.
