**NATIONAL CONSTITUTION CENTER LAUNCHES ITS ‘WINTER WARM UP’ SALE  
 \$10 ADULT/\$5 CHILD TICKETS JANUARY 4, 2016 – MARCH 31, 2016**

Philadelphia (January 4, 2016) – The National Constitution Center today announced its Winter Warm Up sale, running **January 4 through March 31, 2016**. For just \$10 (usually \$14.50) and \$5 for children ages 4-12 (usually \$8), visitors can experience the Center’s main exhibition, take in the live production of *Freedom Rising* before it closes for renovations, view a rare copy of the Bill of Rights in the *Constituting Liberty* exhibit and discover how freedom of religion became a fundamental right in *Religious Liberty and the Founding of America*.

Starting **February 12**, Winter Warm Up visitors will also be able to add the Center’s highly anticipated *Headed to the White House* exhibit to their visit for an additional \$3. The only exhibit of its kind, *Headed to the White House* is created to engage students, teachers, and visitors of all ages with the election season. Using the U.S. Constitution as its launch pad, this hands-on exhibit takes visitors from the campaign trail to Inauguration Day all in one visit.
