Philadelphia, PA (September 8, 2008) – **Live from Balad, Iraq**, U.S. soldiers will join U.S. military families at the National Constitution Center as they celebrate Constitution Day by reciting the powerful words of the Preamble of the Constitution via Skype (Voice over IP Technology) on September 17, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. The recitation, part of the Center's annual *America Reads the Constitution* event, will take place in front of the Preamble Wall, a visually stunning area of the Center's main exhibition, *The Story of We the People*, on which the words of the Preamble are inscribed.

The soldiers at the USO Center in Balad will be joined at the Center by families of soldiers from New Jersey's Maguire Air Force Base and Fort Dix for what will be a historic and undoubtedly emotional reading of 52 of the most significant words in our nation's history. This event is made possible through the Center's partnership with the United Services Organization (USO) of Pennsylvania and Southern New Jersey and CBS 3.
